

Read the written police report pdf file. Watch the videos.

Beginning with the first paragraph. I was travelling south on county road 450 E, following a box truck, when we encountered the officer parked at the church parking lot on the south side of the church, facing mostly west and sitting in the center of the lot as opposed to the paved parking lot edges. The officer could not have made visual contact or track our vehicles through the church building. We passed in front of the officer's vehicle seemingly surprising us both. The formula for speed time and distance with the train A and train B scenario will determine the statements from the officer are a lie. Anyone familiar with the one-mile section of road won't have to do the math.

Why did the officer not turn on his siren and flashing lights to initiate the traffic stop? The officer pulled behind my vehicle and rode my bumper for nearly half of a mile. He speeds into the driveway. What is your game? These are the first words the officer speaks to me. Reference the video provided number 448. I did admit to turning into the drives and turning at the stop sign intersection. The officer was yelling about me "turning off" on him. I stated I turned at the stop sign and then "you came shooting out of the bushes" and I "should call it in". There are four easily sighted drives within 200 yards south of the intersection of 450 E and 300 N. Why was he hiding? "License and registration" he finally shouted and I said "well sure". These are the last words he speaks at my passenger window. I made sure he had eye contact made with me before I took my hands off the steering wheel to remove my seat belt and move to get my license out of my pocket. This is when he slaps the window sill and moves to the driver's door of my vehicle.
